——九三零年八月十五日的晚上，紐約洲最高法院法官 -- 約瑟卡特跟他的家人外出吃過晚飯後，上了一輛計程車，自此之後就再沒有人見過他了。聯邦調查局的調查全部都沒有結果。唯一的線索就是卡特留給他家人的一張便條。便條是這樣寫的：「我非常、非常的疲倦。親愛的約瑟上。」卡特的便條是否也描繪著你現正面對的掙扎呢？
